**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE
FILING OF APPLICATIONS, PERMITS AND LICENSES
AND FOR THE USE OF FACILITIES AND OTHER
SERVICES FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHLAND**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Richland has adopted a codification, consolidation and revision of the ordinances of the Township of Richland; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Richland to eliminate all filing fees, permit fees and license fees from the Code of Ordinances and enact them instead by resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT and it is hereby resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Richland that all fees are hereby fixed as follows:

An additional fee shall be assessed for each building permit issued, is required by Act 13 of 2004, in the amount of \$4 or such other amount that shall be imposed from time to time by acts of the Pennsylvania General Assembly.

In addition to the fees listed above there will be additional inspection fees for alarm system inspections, automatic fire suppression and cooking system inspections, automatic sprinkler inspections, fire pump inspections, standpipe inspections and permit fees for special hazards and operations are also calculated into the final overall inspection and permit fee. All stated additional fees shall be added to the annual inspection fee. Code inspections are limited to witnessing required testing. (Additional fee schedule is attached).</p>
