

## Fire Fund Budget Notes

The Richland Township Board of Supervisors, support five (5) volunteer fire companies: Richland Township Fire and Rescue (formerly Shelly Fire Company), Quakertown Fire Company #1, Quakertown Fire Company #2, Richlandtown Fire Company and Trumbauersville Fire Company. The above fire companies provide superior fire protection all throughout Richland Township.

The fire companies are compensated annually for providing fire protection for Richland Township. In addition to the annual fire protection compensation, Richland Township also supports the fire companies with capital financial contributions. These contributions are used to buy trucks and equipment. The 2012 budgeted capital contributions are listed below:

➤ Richland Township Fire & Rescue	\$ 45,000
➤ Quakertown Fire Company	\$112,000
➤ Trumbauersville Fire Company	\$ 19,000
➤ Richlandtown Fire Company	\$ -0-

In 2012 the Fire Safety Inspection office has a budget of \$7,300. This cost is offset by fees for inspection services and charges for developer reviews.

The Township strives to work closely and assist its local fire companies so they are able to provide protection for all residents of the Township. We encourage our residents to support these companies with their time, talent and treasure.
