

## Verizon DSL

While some areas of Richland Township currently have high speed internet DSL service available through Verizon, some of the more rural sections of the Township have yet to be provided with this service. Thanks to recent action by the Pennsylvania Legislature there is now a program where customers can obtain this service through their phone company. It is called the Bona Fide Retail Request Program (BFRR). Under this program, if 50 customers or 25% of the customers in a designated service area, which ever is less, commit to purchase DSL for a minimum of one year, Verizon will deploy DSL in that area within 12 months.

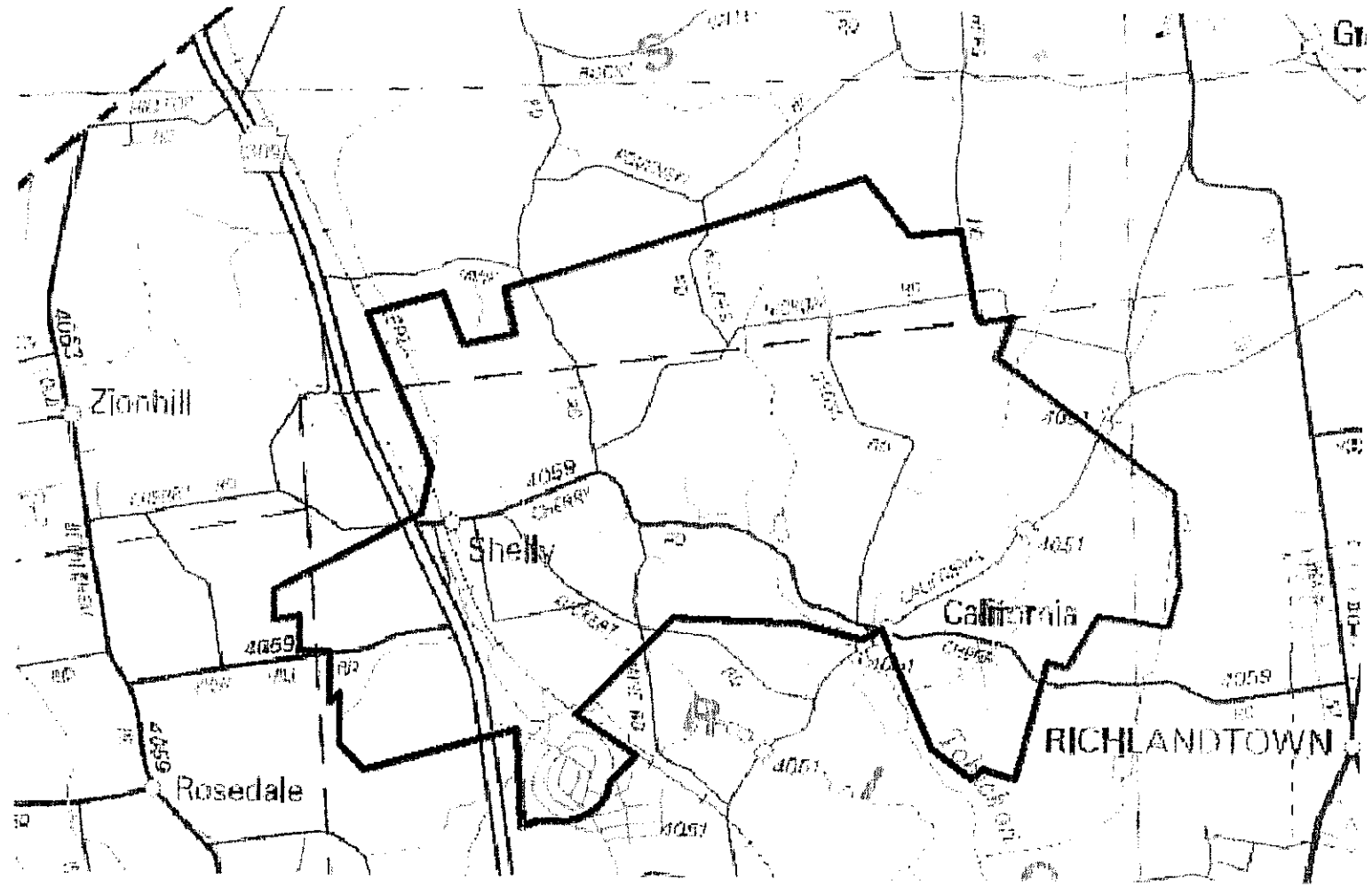
The program allows customers in a designated service area desiring the DSL service to help encourage their neighbors to sign up for the program. Currently two Township residents, JoAnn Renninger of 1552 California Road (Phone # 215-536-2351) and Alberta Cohen of 1581 California Road (Phone # 215-536-6532), are looking for other Township residents in the northwest corner of the Township to sign up for the program in the area shown on the map displayed below.
